Ramadan Mubarak! The year 2020 was a challenging year for many, and it turned out to be an unprecedented year of service for Zakat Chicago. We are so thankful to the donors who overcame their own financial challenges and contributed a record 25% more this year than the last. That was helpful, as we ended up distributing 45% more dollars than in the years past. This report highlights an impact summary of the projects we supported.

Zakat collection and distribution is for sure our major activity, however, in fulfillment of our mission of making Zakat a living institution in Greater Chicago we do more. We made a major effort in 2020 to educate the community about Zakat, provided coordination between Masajid that also collect and distribute Zakat, and brought about the coordination between a dozen food pantries whom we support. These efforts have already yielded very meaningful results that are beneficial to the community.

We maintained our overhead and fundraising expenses remained extremely low, so that most of the donation money went to help the community. We also made significant efforts in the development of the Zakat Chicago organization. We hired a full-time Development Director, hired the services of professional accountants, and subscribed to a state of the art Donor Relations Management software, Alhamdulillah. We appreciate your continued support of our efforts.

2020 Impact Summary

At the beginning of 2020, we saw the rise of COVID-19 and the impact it had on our community almost immediately. Our lives and livelihoods grinded to a halt, our schools and workplaces closed, and, most devastatingly, we saw the loss of life of so many people near and dear to our hearts. This pandemic exacerbated the struggles of so many people in our community-- families that were no longer able to afford to feed their children, people suffering alone as their mental health worsened in social distancing-induced isolation, and the need for Winter Aid for the impending Chicago winter grew more intense. Zakat Chicago recognized the problems facing the community and sought to help as many organizations as possible to fulfill those needs. In order to meet the demand, we spent 46% more in 2020 than in 2019.

Zakat Chicago, a committee of the Council of Islamic Organizations of Greater Chicago (CIOGC), is dedicated to promoting the giving of Zakat, and serving the community in the practice of this third pillar of Islam. Our mission at Zakat Chicago is to establish Zakat as a living institution in the Greater Chicago area.


First organized in 2001, Zakat Chicago has been collecting Zakat and other donations across the Greater Chicago area from Muslim individuals and businesses. The funds collected have been distributed across Chicagoland to various Muslim community projects in accordance with the Quranic guidelines. We are committed to distributing the Zakat to meet the needs of providing for the local community in accordance with our operating principle of "local collection, local distribution." By focusing on these needs Zakat Chicago is able to ensure that the Zakat collected has an immediate and noticeable impact.

Our Growth

Although Zakat Chicago's revenue has been growing steadily since 2004, in 2020 we saw a growth of 25%, alhamdulillah. This is a testimony to the generosity of the Muslim community, who despite the pandemic's effect on themselves saw the need of others as more important.

Our Efficiency

The efficiency of our operations is evident from the data that we spent only 1.5% on overhead and 5.4% on fundraising.



Highlights of Zakat Chicago Ongoing Campaigns

Food Aid

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Zakat Chicago recognized the urgency of food insecurity and immediately went to work by issuing grants and purchasing food and supplies for seven Muslim-owned and operated food pantries across Chicago.

Beyond Zakat Collection & Distribution

Zakat Chicago is the only organization in Greater Chicago that pays significant attention “in service of Zakat” to (a) educating the community about Zakat and (b) coordinating between Zakat collecting and Zakat distributing organizations.


Zakat Education – In 2020, Zakat Chicago compiled and widely distributed a four-page Zakat Basics document. It provided information and guidance sufficient to a majority of Muslims to faithfully uphold their Zakat obligation. In the words and voices of five prominent Chicago-area imams and scholars, Zakat Chicago produced professional quality short video clips on specific topics and widely distributed them.

Zakat Coordination – Zakat Chicago coordinates between Zakat collecting Masajid and Zakat distribution partners.

Zakat Collecting Masajid - Zakat Chicago is holding regular meetings between the Chairs of Masjid Zakat Committees, who not only collect the Zakat, but also distribute to people needing help throughout the year. They have identified the need for a common database of zakat distribution. Zakat Chicago has initiated the effort of establishing one by using Salesforce software, which is in use at a few Masjid already.



Zakat Coordination Meetings between Zakat Chicago and Zakat Chairs from Masajid provide good learning opportunities for all.
